Leslie Goolsby stated that she wants to make the Anchor Graphics building façade to look similar to the proposed hotel on S. Washington Street using brick and stone on the façade with an awning.

Bob Heuman commented that window panes should be safety glass.

Cliff Lunsford suggested that façade should use San Francisco brick which looks aged and weathered.

Leslie Goolsby offered to bring material samples such as brick back to the board.

Bob Heuman stated the he wanted Mrs. Goolsby to bring examples of the brick, stone, and windows back to the board.

Barbie Mays made a motion to approved the certificate of appropriateness request at 224 W. Division Street. The motion was seconded by Cliff Lunsford. The motion passed unanimously.
